- The children go from car to car trunk-r-treating. The event will be held along the road between school and the ball field. The road will be closed off during the event.
- Vehicle owners who register are to bring treats to pass out and are urged to come in costumes. There will be a best dressed vehicle contest, in which “spooky” prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

RULES:

- Proper trunk registration is required to participate. Only properly registered vehicles will be allowed to participate in this event. You must complete and return the attached registration form below.
- Participants **MUST** supply treats to pass out to trick-r-treaters from their vehicle. All treats must be fully wrapped.
- Registered vehicles must arrive at SFS parking lot between 2:30-3:00 p.m. Trunk judging is at 4:00! For safety reasons, all vehicles must remain parked until the end of the event at 7:00 p.m.
- Children **MUST** have an admission bracelet to participate. Bracelets are \$5 and will be sold in the ticket booth areas.
